## From the Baltic to the Black and Adriatic Seas: A Stronger Europe for a Stronger Transatlantic Partnership

*From July 6-7, the Atlantic Council and the Polish Institute of International Affairs invite you to join us for our Global Forum in Warsaw. This Forum marks the occasion of the first visit by US President Donald Trump to Poland en route to the G20 Summit in Hamburg, and takes place in conjunction with the Three Seas Initiative Summit of regional European leaders hosted by Presidents Andrzej Duda of Poland and Kolinda Grabar-Kitarović of Croatia. The Forum will convene leading transatlantic political leaders, business executives, and experts to consider the future of the transatlantic relationship amidst growing regional and global challenges. Participants will exchange views on the state and direction of US-European cooperation, economic strategies to bolster the transatlantic economic relationship, infrastructure development to better leverage the economic potential of Central Europe, the future of Russia's relationship with the West, and the requirements NATO must meet to ensure its effectiveness today and tomorrow. The Forum will also feature targeted business dialogues to help translate the Three Seas leaders' agenda into commercially viable pathways, as well as an exclusive international briefing of Poland's strategic defense review. At the same time, the Forum will play host to the inaugural 360/OS Open Source Summit, a groundbreaking effort to train experts and journalists in open source research and technology. The Forum's capstone is the 9<sup>th</sup> annual Atlantic Council Freedom Awards honoring those who have played critical roles in advancing and defending our freedom.*
